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Rules and Regulations

1. Band members must either be high school students, middle school students or no older than two years out of high school unless authorized by Mrs. Michele Dowdy.
2. Adult bands may participate but will not compete for prize money. Please contact Michele Dowdy at 562-3900, ext. 10234 if interested.
3. To be considered eligible, each band must submit a demo tape, CD, or connection to an internet site of your band performance (please give clear directions to access the site). Or call Mrs. Dowdy and request an audition time.
4. Demo tapes may be audio or video, may not exceed 10 minutes and should contain three musical selections.
5. Applications may be accessed through school music departments, by sending an e-mail request to Michele Dowdy mmdowdy@rcs.k12.va.us or obtained at the office of School Counseling Services at the Roanoke County Schools Central office.
6. Demo tapes and applications must be turned in to Mrs. Dowdy at the Roanoke County Schools Central office School Counseling Department by February 15, 2010.
7. Additional auditions may be required and you will be notified in the event that a live audition is required.
8. All bands will be notified by February 26 if they have been selected to compete.
9. Absolutely no cursing, profane or suggestive language is allowed. This includes no reference to drug or alcohol use or sexual innuendos. Offensive language at the event will result in immediate disqualification and all band members will be required to leave the event.
10. This is a school sponsored event and all school rules apply. Students are expected to cooperate completely with staff and volunteers.
11. Sound System equipment will be provided. Drum sets will be provided.
12. Bands selected to compete will be assigned a time for a sound check between 4:00pm and 6:00 pm on Friday, March 26 at Northside High School. Each band must appear for the sound check at the assigned time.
13. Each band is responsible for their equipment, including keyboard instruments.
14. Ten minutes will be allowed for set-up and break down between bands.
15. Each band will be allowed 15 minutes to perform.
16. A \$25.00 entry fee will be collected from each band selected to compete.
